3 Alton Road Application--Silver Birch -Fell.

Oxton Society Comment--This is a large and mature tree and its removal would have a significant effect on the tree vista .However , it is suggested that it is diseased at the base but we were not able to view the base due to a high wall.Hence we are unable to comment but if in the view of the professional it was diseased we would not oppose the application.
