- 2. **Approval of minutes.** The minutes of the last meeting were approved.

3. Conservation/Planning

- a. Planning
 - 1. 1-3 Shrewsbury Road. DW visited the property and recorded its state as just about serviceable. There are no potential buyers or development proposals known of as yet. Price was considered very high. **Action AC** to contact Brennan Ayre O'Neal to carry out a formal society visit.
 - 2. Ashton House. Another new planning officer handling this case. Decision expected "soon" (AB)
- b. Local Plan. New govt proposals on revised new house build numbers is likely to force a review of the Local Plan at an early stage of its life (<5 years?). This might place pressure on the "No build on green belt" restriction in the plan.
- c. Street name signs. JH to survey and draw up proposal of costs.
- d. Local Listing. Project to start autumn/early 2025. Scope to be published by WBC in due course.
