

## Go wild for wildlife!

Can you let a corner of your garden go a little wild this summer?

Try joining in with 'No Mow May' to help native flowers grow. Leave a log pile for insects or choose pollinator-friendly plants to encourage bees and butterflies.

Litter kills around 3 million animals every year (RSPCA). You can help protect our wild neighbours by doing a litter pick while you're out for a walk. Or try refill to cut down on single use plastics.



Even a tiny pond can make a big difference for wildlife. An old bowl sunk into the ground can create a home for frogs and newts. And offer a welcome drink to birds, hedgehogs and even foxes.
